



Private Alfred Alexander Webb



13th London Regiment (Kensington)

Died 8 May 1918

Age 22

Private Alfred Alexander Webb is commemorated on the list of War Dead at All Saints' Church.

He was born in 1896 in Sheperds Bush, and died on 8th May 2018 of wounds sustained in battle in Flanders. He was aged 22.

He is buried in the Ligny-St. Flochel British Cemetery in Averdingt, Pas de Calais, France. His Gravestone is engraved with the words "Our Loving Son and Brother. Peace Perfect Peace".

In 1915 he lived at 121 Felsham Road with his Father and Mother, Alfred George and Annie Webb and his younger brother Gordon Hector Webb.

Prior to this the family lived in 4a Salvin Road and soon after Private Webb died they moved to 105 Felsham Road.

Alfred's father was a Coal Merchant's salesman and in the 1911 census, when he was 15, Alfred's occupation is given as 'Office Boy'.

Alfred was in the 13th London Regiment (Kensington).
