Daily Bread – Extra Slice – and The Church of England's month of prayer

During the last lockdown many found value in being united in prayer despite being dispersed. The Bishop of Southwark called us to a 7pm time of prayer and to light a candle at home. This second lockdown the Archbishops of Canterbury and York have called those moved, and able, to consider a Thursday fast (in you are unable to physically fast you can discuss spiritual fasting with any of the clergy team). In conjunction with this, and to aid your home prayers, the Daily Bread reflections will resume and be sent out via Church Mouse.

Parish Advent Group: Freedom and Hope

Join us for this year's Advent course, 'Freedom and Hope', when in four sessions we will be exploring the Advent themes of freedom and hope through Bible study, music, art, and discussion:

We began on **18**th **November** by looking at how the biblical story of the Exodus has shaped understandings of who God is, and how different groups have taken this story as their inspiration in their struggles for freedom.

On **25**th **November** we will look at the second most significant story of liberation in the Hebrew Bible, the return from exile in Babylon, and the hopes that developed at this time for a future king or Messiah.

On **2**nd **December** our focus will be on Jesus, and the extent to which he fulfilled or contradicted the hopes of his people. Why is a crucified Messiah a source of hope today? What does his resurrection mean?

Finally, on **9**th **December** we will think about freedom and hope in the Christian life today. What kinds of freedom is the Christian faith concerned with? What does it mean to hope?

Posada 2020 (Spanish for Inn)

In many Spanish and Latin countries there is a tradition kept between 16th – 24th December of small versions of Mary and Joseph, and often a donkey, travelling around different households in the community to 'stay' for one night. Mary and Joseph make their progression to the church for ready for Christmas Eve.

Essentially this is an Advent prayer activity for those who host the figures and share the Christmas story with family and friends, before passing it on to the next host.

This year, passing on things between households isn't possible, but what is possible is to make a space for Mary and Joseph and the coming Christ-child in your homes as part of your prayers and preparations.

This year we are asking you to make your own Mary and Joseph and invite you to send in an image of what you have made to Rev'd Jono (Jonathan.Haynes@parishofputney.co.uk). Images received may be posted on our social media (one or more each day depending on how many we get) so by sending in your photos you are giving consent for this.

No idea what we will get, but we're expecting a mix of Lego, Barbie, Sylvanians, plasticine, playmobil, beanie boos, knitwear who knows – you may choose to build the inn or the stable, or both, or just have Mary and Joseph and their faithful donkey (or ...??), its entirely up to you!

On Christmas Eve why not add the baby Jesus, and even keep the holy family somewhere as focus, until you mark putting them away following an Epiphany home blessing, the clergy would be delighted to do that for you, in January.

This simple and homemade effort is both for the family and something shared with others, and another way of participating together as Advent moves into Christmas and we make space for the holy family and the Christ-child in our homes and our hearts.
