### Epiphany Chalk Blessing for 2021: 20 + C + M + B + 21

There is a custom of blessing homes around the Feast of the Epiphany. Traditionally individuals, couples or a family will gather to ask God's blessing on their home and home-life. Other times a priest will come and say prayers. However this it is done, it is an invitation for Jesus to be a daily guest in our homes. To mark it: the door, lintel or similar are chalked with the year and C M and B for the names of the three wise men (Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar, it also makes the initials of "*Christ bless this house*" in Latin, *Christus Mansionem Benedicat*). This year following the 10:30am service on Sunday at St Mary's chalk and prayers will be available for you to take away and offer prayers for your homes. In the year ahead, may God's blessing be upon you and where you live.

## Toy Collection

Thank you so much for the generous gifts you donated before Christmas to the toy collection which supported the Roehampton Community Box Project. We delivered 5 boxes of gifts to the project centre on 14<sup>th</sup> December.

Each family that collected a box before Christmas had the opportunity to choose 3 books, 2 small gifts and 1 large gift and much of that came from our Parish donations. That week they distributed 240 double size food boxes and 240 Christmas bags full of treats.

Since 26<sup>th</sup> March 2020, the Box Project has given out 6,869 food boxes supporting families across 15 schools and nurseries centred in Roehampton but reaching into Putney, Sheen, Barnes and Battersea.
